The fund is passively managed and focuses on the US market. The fund aims to generate a return and risk profile in line with its benchmark, aside from the exclusions made based on the fund company's sustainability policy. The fund's benchmark is the MSCI USA Net Return Index, a reinvesting equity index comprised of large and mid-sized companies in the US market. The fund promotes sustainability-related properties by excluding companies, business models and products that are deemed to affect the climate, society, or stakeholders negatively. The fund's active corporate governance process aims to drive and influence the development of the companies it invests in. As the fund has a different base currency than SEK, the return may be affected by changes in exchange rates. In the fund's currency-hedged share class, however, the ambition is to hedge the share class currency against the fund's base currency, which means that the exchange rate change between these currencies is reduced. Even if the aim is for currency hedging to remove the effect of exchange rate fluctuations, costs associated with the process will mean that the result of currency hedging varies.
